#### **Fund Global Research**

- The largest private funder of ALS research worldwide.
- Thanks to the ALS Ice Bucket Challenge, we are now spending three times more than on ALS Research than before summer 2014.
- Supports a wide breadth of specific fields of study that are critical to advancing ALS research (AT, Biomarkers, Disease Models/Mechanisms, Clinical Studies, Genetics, Drug Development, Stem Cells etc.)

The ALS Association is aggressively advocating for legislative priorities that will help to:

#### **Federal Accomplishments**

- National ALS Registry (launched October 2010)
  - Single largest ALS research project ever created.
  - Designed to identify ALS cases throughout the United States via an online web portal, as well as from existing national health databases (Medicare & VA)
  - Collecting critical information about ALS that will improve care, help us learn what causes ALS, how it can be treated and even prevented.
- Veterans Benefits
  - Established ALS as a 100% service-connected disease (Sept 2008)
  - Vets with ALS and survivors have over \$500M in benefits disability compensation and full health care.
- Waiver of waiting periods for Medicare (24 month) and SSDI (5 months)
- FDA Advocacy Relyvrio (2022) and Toferson (2023)

## **Public Policy**

#### **State Accomplishments**

- Bitner Plante ALS Initiative of Florida
  - Established July 1, 2013
  - Provides state funding to support Florida's Certified Centers of Excellence
  - Results:
    - 6-7 clinic days per month in 2013 vs. 22.5 clinic days per month today
